April Activities and Announcements

- 1. <u>The Knights continue to sponsor and lead the rosary</u> 25 to 30 minutes before the Masses of the first Saturday and first Sunday of the month. For April it's Saturday the 2nd and Sunday the 3rd. The next rosary will be the Sunday May 1 and Saturday May 7. After the Mass, the Rosary is the most perfect prayer which Mary gave us.
- 2. Eucharistic Adoration in Celebration of the Jubilee Year of Mercy on Divine Mercy Sunday April 3 after the 10 am Mass until 4 pm. Please kneel/sit in the front row left as part of a Knights of Columbus Honor Guard. You can do spiritual reading; converse with the Lord; listen to Him; and share your innermost thoughts and concerns with Him to obtain healing and strength to keep going. The recommended community intention for April is God's mercy for us and for the virtue of having mercy on others, especially upon those who have offended us or need our help. The next Eucharistic Adoration is Sunday May 1.
- 3. <u>First Bonanza Raffle Turn-in</u> April 15. Proceeds support Knights of Columbus charities all over the world. This first turn-in is critical because it gives our Council the maximum rebate that we use to finance the scholarships we give to high schools seniors of our parish.
