2. <u>K of C Mother's Day Breakfast</u> - *Sunday May 10 after the 8 am and 10 am Masses* (2nd Sunday of each month) for St. Louis K of C Council Charities. It will be free for mothers. Honor not only the mother in your family, but also by your presence pay homage to all the mothers within our parish family.
