WHAT ARE YOU DOING FOR YOUR MARRIAGE TODAY? It doesn't have to be "my way". Look for the best way and complement her when she comes up with a better way. Recognize her special gifts and talents. - Eucharistic Adoration Sunday February 5 after the 10 am Mass. The Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will conclude with Vespers and Benediction at 4 pm. It would be great to have a Knights of Columbus Honor Guard there. Brother Knight, if you come for adoration, please kneel/sit in the front row on the left for as long as you desire, be it only 15 minutes or more. You don't have to be in regalia. Former Grand Knight Bruce Davison usually occupies the first row on the right for most of the time, including the all-nighters. You can do spiritual reading; converse with the Lord; and share your innermost thoughts and concerns with Him to obtain healing and strength to keep going. The recommended community intention for February is for our new president.....that he may exercise his grave duties with wisdom and humility, always seeking the will of God. The next one will be on Sunday March 5. There is also adoration at 7 8 am on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays before Mass.
