People from Noble County, Parkersburg, Marietta, St. Louis Church, Sacred Heart Pomeroy, and St. Ambrose were among those who rode the two buses. It was heart warming to see among the marchers so many seminarians and young people, including children, toddlers, and babies. There were delegations from colleges such as Franciscan University of Steubenville and Benedictine University. Most of the over 300,000 people in the March were women who wanted no part in the so called "Women's March on Washington". A cop told me that they had a much greater number than we did. Fr. Tom and Tim Stapleton also participated in the March, but are not in the picture.

## Activities and Announcements for Lent and the Month of March

- 1. Eucharistic Adoration Sunday March 5 after the 10 am Mass. The Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will conclude with Vespers and Benediction at 4 pm. You will often feel the Lord's presence while experiencing peace, consolation, and warmth. It would be great to have a Knights of Columbus Honor Guard there. Brother Knight, if you come for adoration, please kneel/sit in the front row on the left for as long as you desire, be it only 15 minutes or more. You don't have to be in regalia. Former Grand Knight Bruce Davison usually occupies the first row on the right for most of the time, including the all-nighters. You can do spiritual reading; converse with the Lord; and share your innermost thoughts and concerns with Him to obtain healing and strength to keep going. The recommended community intention for March is for a fruitful Lent in our Parish. That we will all become closer to God as we relive Christ's 40 days of preparation in the desert and His Passion. That we will take Sunday Mass, Adoration, and parish devotions more seriously with deeper participation.
- <u>The Knights continue to sponsor and lead the rosary</u> 25 to 30 minutes before the Masses of the first Saturday and first Sunday of the month. For March it's Saturday the 4<sup>th</sup> and Sunday the 5<sup>th</sup>. The next rosary will be on the week end of April 1 2. After the Mass, the Rosary is the most perfect prayer which Mary gave us.
- 3. <u>K of C Benefit Breakfast</u> Sunday March March 12 after the 8 am and 10 am Masses (generally the 2nd Sunday of each month). It will be great fellowship and delicious food with a lot of love added to it to strengthen our parish community. Bring your family and friends. This one will benefit the Rewiring Project of our church. We need your help to setup and prepare the food at 7 am, washing dishes, and cleaning up after each of the two breakfasts.
