Cheer them on and encourage even when their best falls short. Prepare your sons for Christian manhood and be the kind of guy your daughters should marry. Love your daughters in the right way or they will find false love in the wrong way. Be a good role model, an example of a true man of God. Be the spiritual leader in your home with Christ at the center. You have a great influence on the lives of each one of your children. Constantly pray for them and with them. The family that prays together, stays together.

Activities and Announcements for the Month of July

- 1. The Knights continue to sponsor and lead the rosary 25 to 30 minutes before the Masses of the first Saturday and first Sunday of the month. For July it's Sunday the 1st and Saturday the 7th. The next rosary will be on the week end of August 4 and 5. After the Mass, the Rosary is the most perfect prayer which Mary herself gave us. Our Lady urges us to pray the rosary for peace daily; the need is urgent. Live the Fatima message! Continue to offer your aches and pains, problems and frustrations, disappointments and failures to Jesus through Mary for the conversion of sinners and the poor souls in purgatory. First thing out of bed......offer up your day. Pray the rosary at home; the family that prays together, stays together.
- 2. Eucharistic Adoration Sunday July 1 after the 10 am Mass. The Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will conclude with Vespers and Benediction at 4 pm. It would be great to have a Knights of Columbus Honor Guard there. Brother Knight, if you come for adoration, please kneel/sit in the front row on the left for as long as you desire, be it only 15 minutes or more. You don't have to be in regalia. Former Grand Knight Bruce Davison usually occupies the first row on the right for most of the time, including the all-nighters. You can do spiritual reading; converse with the Lord; and share your innermost thoughts and concerns with Him to obtain healing and strength to keep going. The recommended community intention for July is our Country and for religious freedom everywhere. The next one will be on Sunday August 5. There is also adoration at 7 8 am before morning daily Mass.
- 3. MOST IMPORTANT Business Dinner Meeting this month Monday July 30 at 6:30 pm with Rosary at 6 pm in the church at Mary's altar. We will have the installation of the new officers and decide the awards for 2018.
