Activities and Announcements for the Month of December

- 1. <u>No Business Dinner Meeting This Month</u> There will be no meeting in December because of the 12 days of Christmas.
- 2. First Saturday Mass and Rosary December 1 at 8 am. There is also Mass on the other Saturdays of the month at 8 am. The Mass readings are for Saturday while the 5:30 Vigil Mass has the readings for Sunday and thus fulfills the Sunday obligation. On December 10, 1925. Mary appeared to Lucia with the following message in her own words: "Behold, my daughter, my Heart encircled with thorns, with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. Give me consolation, you, at least; and make known on my behalf that I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all who on the First Saturday of five consecutive months confess their sins, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the Rosary, and keep me company for fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, with the purpose of making reparation to my Immaculate Heart."
- 3. <u>The Knights continue to sponsor and lead the rosary</u> 25 to 30 minutes before the Masses of the first Saturday and first Sunday of the month. For December it's Saturday the 1st and Sunday the 2nd. The next rosary will be on the weekend of January 5-6. After the Mass, the Rosary is the most perfect prayer which Mary herself gave us. Our Lady urges us in her Fatima message to pray the rosary for peace daily as a sacrifice for the conversion of sinners; the need is urgent.
- 4. <u>The Hours of Eucharistic Adoration for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception</u> will be announced. It would be great if every knight in our Council would sign up for an hour of the day or night to kneel on the side of our former Grand Knight, thus forming an Honor Guard. Brother Knight, if you come for adoration, please kneel/sit in the front row on the left for as long as you desire, be it only 15 minutes or more. You don't have to be in regalia. You can do spiritual reading; converse with the Lord; and share your innermost thoughts and concerns with Him to obtain healing and strength to keep going. *The recommended community prayer intention for December* is that the people of our Country keep Christ in Christmas.
- 5. <u>K of C Benefit Breakfast</u> Sunday December 9 after the 8 am and 10 am Masses (2nd Sunday of each month). It will be great fellowship and delicious food with a lot of love added to it to strengthen our parish community. Bring your family and friends. There is no charge, but donations will be accepted for the benefit of the March For Life by those who will represent our parish. We need your help to setup and prepare the food at 7 am, washing dishes, and cleaning up after each of the two breakfasts. Help to build parish community with your presence.

6. <u>We'll need your help to put up the Christmas decorations</u> on Saturday Morning December 15 at 9 am.

- 7. <u>Knights of Columbus Fifth Sunday Mass</u> *Sunday December 30 at 10 am*. The 4th Degree knights will process in full regalia and make the Mass more beautiful and impressive than it already is. The knights will do it all; Fr. Tom is also a knight. We will all *meet in the back of the church at 9:45 am*. Come for the pre-Mass rosary at 9:20 am.
- 8. <u>Recruit new members</u> for our council. We need new blood, real men we can count on to actively participate, to come to meetings, to take leadership roles, and to pull their weight. Talk up the knights. Tell the guys about the great fellowship, opportunities to serve the parish and community, and the great life insurance program that we have. Then we'll be ready to send a delegation for the next official induction of new knights.
