You can do spiritual reading; converse with the Lord; listen to Him; and share your innermost thoughts and concerns with Him to obtain healing and strength to keep going. You will find peace. The recommended community prayer intention for August is for the renewal of our parish, that each Mass be standing

room only, that we have a solid parish community faithful to Our Lord and His Church.
